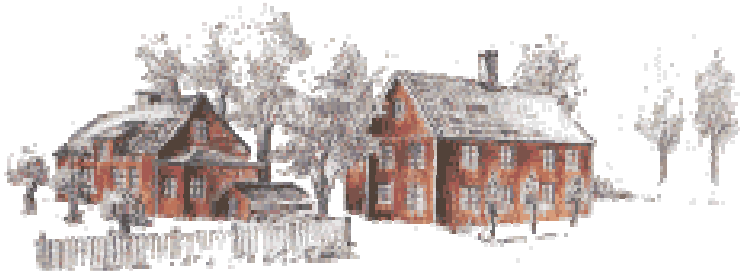

## TEKNISKA MUSEET

The Technical museum was founded in 1924 by the Engineering science Academy, Sweden's Industry union, Sweden's Invention society and Sweden's Technology Society. The building in functional style was designed by the architect Ragnar Hjorth and was inaugurated in 1936. The museum became a foundation in 1947 and has since 1964 been supported by the State.

The technical museum, which is Sweden's biggest technical museum, has a national commission to be responsible for the technical and the industrial historical cultural heritage. The exhibit area is 10.000 m<sup>2</sup> and the museum has approximately 170.000 visitors a year.

The museum's collections contain just over 55.000 objects. 1.000 meters archive documents, 200.000 drawings, 1.000.000 pictures and just over 56.000 books. The Technical Museum also takes care of documentation work to keep memories and stories, technique and processes.
